

POSTAL SUBSIDY BILL

IT NOW AWAITS THE PRESIDENT'S SIGNATURE

Paddock's Pure Food Measure Tacked on to the Articular Bill—Signatures of Public Health Inspectors All Alike

WASHINGTON, March 2.—The senate met at 9:30. The general deficiency bill was reported and Mr. Hale gave notice that he would ask for its consideration today.
