Napoleon held with a Convent. Received instructions to accompany Napoleon to Strasbourg, so as to be ready to follow his headquarters according to circumstances (September, 1850). An attack which he executed at the beginning of the campaign alarmed me peculiarly.

The very day of his departure from Strasbourg I was dining with him in a room in the Empress's apartments, and he was in a very good humor, as if in an abrupt manner. I was in the drawing room; he took me by the arm and brought me to his room. M. de Remusat, his chief chamberlain, followed me into the room, and was afraid Napoleon might go without giving them a word, and he had no other way of making his presence known to the emperor than to follow him. He scolded him to tell me to close the door, I tore upon his neck, and he did not utter a word.

He did not vomit; he groaned and foamed at the mouth. M. de Remusat gave him some water, I immolated him with some cognac. He had something in the line of convulsion, which ceased in about a quarter of an hour.
