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Housing Work People. At the twenty-fourth annual general meeting of the Artisans, Laborers and General Dwellings Company (limited) it was reported that the income for the year 1900 amounted to more than £130,000, the net revenue being £88,000, out of which dividends amounting to £24,000 had been paid. The increase in capital during the year had been £100,000, with premiums amounting to £14,000, the total amount paid up being £1,767,500, the authorized capital being £2,000,000 in ordinary shares and £750,000 in preference shares, 44 per cent. The revenue and capital reserves now amount to £288,140.

The completed estates of the company in London are Shaftesbury park, S. W., and Queen's park, W., comprising nearly 3,500 separate houses. At Noel park, N., at the close of the year 1,288 houses had been built, nearly being let and occupied. This estate when completed will comprise 2,800 houses. An estate of sixty-six acres had been acquired in Stratford-upon-Avon, and lodged in the same manner as the other suburban parks of the company.
