

RIOT AND BLOODSHED

They Are Feared in New York City.

Tammany Inspectors and U. S. Inspectors May Have a Clash.

NEW YORK, Nov. 3.—There is danger of an open conflict at the polls in this city next Tuesday between the Tammany police and the United States deputy marshals under John I. Davenport.

The Republicans insist that under the state law it takes three inspectors of election to constitute a quorum. Tammany's police board has decided of itself that the two Tammany inspectors on each board constitute a quorum.

John I. Davenport claims that his deputies may be stationed within the booths and announces in language more or less complimentary to the United States marshals that he will be "yanked out" of the polling booth there.

There are 1,197 polling precincts in the city. Two polling precincts in the United States deputy marshals will be on duty at each place. Reserve forces of police and reserve forces of inspectors will be stationed at convenient points.
