DESTITUTION AT HOMEAST.

The Chicago Investigating Committee found out.

The Chicago Homestead Relief and Aid society reports a deplorable condition of affairs at Homeast. The following description is given by a member of the visiting committee:

We did our work as much as possible without making ourselves known. We desired to find out the true situation, and whether or not any more assistance would be needed. It would be putting the case mildly to say that we found a very sad condition of affairs. It was simply deplorable. We found that a very small proportion of the old men had been taken back. There is a list in the company's office and each man who will be re-employed has a mark opposite his name. No man can secure employment unless he signs an agreement to withdraw from the union and never again join it. Eighteen hundred men are still out of employment and it is safe to say that two-thirds of them are heads of families. Many of these men were formerly prominent citizens of Homeast. To illustrate the poverty that exists I have to state that in three cases we have seen men who are unable to save human life. These are in the case of the families of John McCreary, Mrs. Edwards and Mrs. Partridge. They have from five to seven children each, and there was neither coal, food nor clothing. There is a list in the house owned by the company they are unable to be turned out into the streets. She has had to render assistance to a relief committee, which is composed of men who are still out of employment and they are all now begging for help. STOVES.

A new invention.

Mr. Harvey Cliff has patented a stove which is now on exhibition in the house warming apparatus of the day. The stove gives out its heat by vaporizing kerosene or petroleum. Takes up in floor space 14x16 inches and is 38 inches high. The remarkable feature about it is the economy with which it can give out a great heat with the small expenditure of fuel.

The great trouble with burning kerosene in the past, as a fuel, lay in the fact that it is so easily extinguished. This is obviated in this case by the pressure of air which is forced into the tank containing the kerosene. As a result, the flame getting back to the oil and causing an explosion. The present model, according to Mr. Cliff, is so constructed that it is just where Mr. Cliff has made his success, and other efforts in the past has failed. The prominent insurance man of the city have seen the stove and are willing to pay an amount of insurance on the house or building which uses it. Another valuable quality which the stove possesses is that it is so constructed that it heats pure cold air, two large air tubes pass through the stove and are heated by the air which is forced into the tank. This cold air then passes through these pipes and becomes hot and purified before being supplied from the top of the stove, which has a hot air register.
