New York, Dec. 7.—The will of the late Jay Gould was given out this afternoon by Judge Dillon for the executor.

The first specific bequest is given to his sister, Mrs. Northrop, of three lots of land at Camden, N. Y., worth \$25,000 and \$20,000 annually during her life.

His beloved son, George J. Gould, had developed remarkable business ability, having for 25 years devoted himself entirely to my business and during the past five years taken entire control of all my interests.

All the rest of the estate is bequeathed to the executor, who is to provide for the maintenance of the children and to pay the income thereof to each child for life.
