Abstract:	The Peninsular Club was a private social club in Grand Rapids, Michigan from 1881 to 2010. This is a devised collection bringing together documents associated with the club from numerous accessions. In late 2008, the Peninsular Club donated many of their own historical files, images and publications to the Library. This collection includes correspondence, registers, ephemera, directories, yearbooks, the Peninsular Club magazine, scrapbooks and some photographs.

The Clubhouse

The 75th anniversary booklet, included in this collection, shows images and provides information on the three buildings which have been the Clubs home.

First in 1881, the Morton home served the group. It was at the corner of Ottawa and Pearl, then located up on a hill. This building was built by Daniel Ball in the 1850s of brick and stone, part of the old Prospect Hill site, before the grading to street level, that has existed for over 100 years. This building was demolished in 1888.

The second home, and the clubs first building, was built in 1883 on the same site as the current (1914) building, at the corner of Ottawa and Fountain St. The entrance was on Fountain Street at that time.

In 1913, during the construction of the Club's present home, the club took up residence in the Keeler Building on Division, while the old building was demolished and the new one

constructed on the same site. The main entrance was on Ottawa street in the new building, but there was also an entrance from Fountain St. during much of the life of the building.

Series III. Publications

Scope and Contents

The Directories, Membership Rosters and Yearbooks issued by the Club may prove to be successive generations of essentially the same publication, as it evolved through time, or was handling differently under different leadership generations.

The early yearbooks were typical of yearbooks of other organizations of that time, including the names of officers and members, and the constitution and bylaws of the organization.

The later membership rosters were essentially the same publication, but now including pictures of leaders, and contact information for members, including the first name of the wife. Being still a male dominated organization, one can find the names of single males included in this directory, but are hard pressed to find a single female member listed.

The most recent manifestation of this document currently in the collection, from 1998/1999, is call the Directory/Year Book. Womens are now pictured among the Club's leaders. Still a couple dominated organization, there are men and women singles occasionally found. A newer section gives information on Reciprocal Clubs in other cities, and there is more emphasis on the Athletic Club aspect of the organization, as well as space rental information. Email addresses and cell phone numbers are not yet prominent in the directory information, though can be expected in later directories.

Series IV. Peninsular Club News / Peninsular Club Magazine

Scope and Contents

Beginning with v. 1, no. 1, Nov. 1934 as the Peninsular Club News, a sometimes irregular monthly publication was established for the Club, which grew into the Peninsular Club Magazine valued by many during its time, and by researchers today.

Found in the Dec. 2008 gift of holdings from the Club, after the sale of their building, is a mock up issues of the "Peninsular Club News" dated March 1924. Whether this was an early plan for a publication which didn't develop until 1934, or a reminiscences issues, which may never have been published, it stands on its own as a publication design artifact, associated with this series.

Change title to the Peninsular Club Magazine with v. 16, no. 6, June 1948. Changed frequency to quarterly with 1967 (Winter/Spring/Roster/Fall), and suspended us of volume & issue numbers. Ceased publication with the Fall 1971 issue, per the title page, to be continued by the Peninsular Club Newsletter.
